



COME IN EKvW Scholarship

Scholarship for visiting/exchange students from EKvW partner institutions outside Europe

In order to give students from universities of partner churches of the EKvW (Evangelical Church of Westphalia) outside Europe the opportunity to take part in the International Study Programme at the Protestant University of Applied Sciences (EvH RWL) in Bochum, the EvH RWL is awarding a **COME IN EKvW scholarship** for the summer semester of 2023.

What does the scholarship involve?

The COME IN EKvW scholarship includes the costs for board and lodging, flight, visa and insurance. The home university of the scholarship holder (or the scholarship holder) needs to pay the semester contribution (approx. 340 euros) which includes also the public transport ticket for the whole region.

Who can apply?

Application is open to students from universities of partner churches of Evangelical Church of Westphalia (EKvW)

- who are located outside Europe and cannot be supported within the terms of the ERASMUS+ programme (EU),
- who are recommended by their organisation or university for a semester abroad at the EvH RWL
- who have sufficient English language skills (at least level B1 in terms of CEFRL).

Application and selection

Those who are interested should contact the International Office or the appropriate contact person at their university. They will nominate one student per university for the scholarship.

The selected students must submit their application to the EvH **by 31 October 2022**, including the following documents:

- Application form for the COME IN EKvW scholarship (see next page)
- Letter of motivation (Personal statement, 1-2 pages)
- Brief curriculum vitae (CV)
- Further documents needed for the registration at our university (please see www.evh-bochum.de/exchange-students-erasmus.html: Completed registration form for exchange students, copy of passport or ID card)

Consideration can only be given to applications which are submitted on time.

 - Costs for flight, visa and health insurance (directly paid by EKvW or EvH RWL)
- I am aware that the following costs are not part of the scholarship and must be paid by myself:
- Costs for further personal needs (e.g. leisure activities).
- I am aware that the following costs are not part of the scholarship and must be paid by my home university or myself:
- Semester contribution incl. ticket for public transport in the entire region of North Rhine-Westphalia (approx. 340 euros).
- If I am selected as a scholarship holder, I am aware that I must provide the following services:
- Regular participation in the seminars and events of the International Study Programme ISP.
 - Participation in feedback and reflection meetings.
 - Writing a final report at the end of the stay.
 - Participation in a virtual evaluation meeting after the stay.
